Lacewing cock. His father is a
BSNSW winning lacewing and
was bred from the sister of my
national winning hen. His
mother was a green cinnamon
hen bred from the brother of
the National winning hen.**

*The Yannakis and Lawless-Pyne
lacewings were imported from the
UK by Garry Yannakis in the Russel
Woods syndicate. They were
purchased from Mick Harvey who at
the time was one of the best
lacewing breeders in the UK .There
were very few lacewings imported
into Australia in the importation
syndicates . The birds themselves
were good quality and superb
variety. They produced birds much
better than themselves. They were
line bred for a number of years and
then out-crossed to birds from
Rodney Harris(UK) line imported by
Russell Woods. (Thanks Russell).
These birds were from "Joe
Mannes" HERCULES LINE.
Obviously it was easy to maintain
quality using these birds but special
attention was paid to variety
characteristics .i.e. dark cinnamon
markings and clarity of markings.
This line has been very successful at
every level. Best lacewing at the
BSNSW for 3 consecutive years
2008, 2009, 2010 with multiple
annual show wins. Our best
achievement was the National
winning Lacewing in 2008
with multiple progeny making it to
the top 20 in the state challenge in
the last 4 years. The 2011 result was
2nd in State challenge 12th in the
National.*
